FUNDS RAISED

ABAM raised \$50,000 in 2022 to support women across the nation diagnosed with breast cancer - totaling \$450,000 over the past 14 years.

IMPACT

In 2021, Image Reborn served 58 survivors at 8 in-person renewal retreats and another 169 through 23 virtual wellness workshops.

This year, over 120 women are anticipated to attend 15 in-person retreats and approximately 60 alumni will receive ongoing care through virtual programs.
